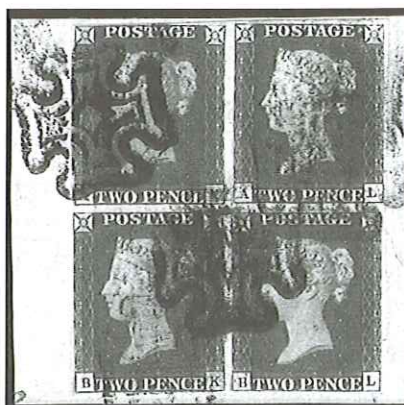

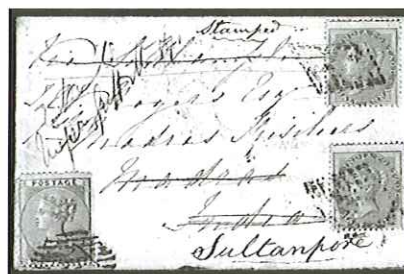
Cover written by Brigadier-General Henry Havelock from Allahabad to Prussia dated in manuscript 3rd July 1857.



Brigadier-General Havelock was appointed to command the MOVEABLE COLUMN on June 20th 1857. His orders were to relieve CANNOR and LUDLOW but to first quell all disturbances at Allahabad.

The General and his staff reached Allahabad on June 30th where he joined his command. On the day he wrote this letter, Havelock received intelligence of the massacre at CANNOR and the fall of the city to NANA SINGH.

This letter took ten days to reach BERNES (BRUNNEN BRUNNEN IN GREEN). From there it was sent by boat to Calcutta where the postage stamps were cancelled at the General Post Office and a red Calcutta handstamp applied.

THE ARMY OF OUDH.

Accused as an Officer destined at Lucknow dated on arrival 2nd July 1858.



MANUSCRIPT MARKING ON REVERSE: "Capt Calcutta with detachment of H.M. 1st Madras Europeans, Lucknow" and other troops under Capt. Gordon to join 1st Madras Europeans, Lucknow."

HISTORICAL NOTE: The 1st Madras European Fusiliers were part of the Lucknow garrison in April 1858, after its relief. At the end of April, as part of Major-General F.H. Grant's column, the Fusiliers moved into the Bassein district on May 10th. The column arrived before the strong fort at Dundikhra, but finding the rebels had left, the force marched back to Lucknow having suffered considerably from sunstroke.

INDIAN MUTINY 1857-59

Officers' cover written to Lieutenant H.M.B. BURLTON, 5th BENGAL NATIVE INFANTRY, at POOL BARR Gwalior, from France dated 9th October 1858.



Lt. BURLTON was serving at this time with MERDES HOSSE, part of Brigadier M.W. SMITH'S DIVISION OF THE RAJPUTANA FIELD FORCE operating in CENTRAL INDIA.

At the end of September 1858, Brigadier SMITH'S force was ordered to assist the GWALKER DIVISION, commanded by Brigadier R. NAPIER, in the pursuit of the rebel chief TANTIA TOPSI.

On November 14th, Brigadier SMITH'S column moved against MACK SINHA, another rebel leader who was at KUNDRI with a large force. Even though the mutineers were defeated with heavy losses, MACK SINHA managed to escape capture. SMITH'S force assembled at the village of RAIPUR after the engagement.

The letter landed at BOMBAY - note boxed handstamp on reverse "BOMBAY/18 NOV 11/BEARING 1", from where it was sent to the post office accompanying the CENTRAL INDIA FORCES. Note the handstamp - A double circle 27 and 17mm in diameter enclosing the legend "CENTRAL INDIA FIELD FORCE 19/NOV/1858/P.O." which was used even though the CENTRAL INDIA FIELD FORCE was officially broken up on June 29th 1858.

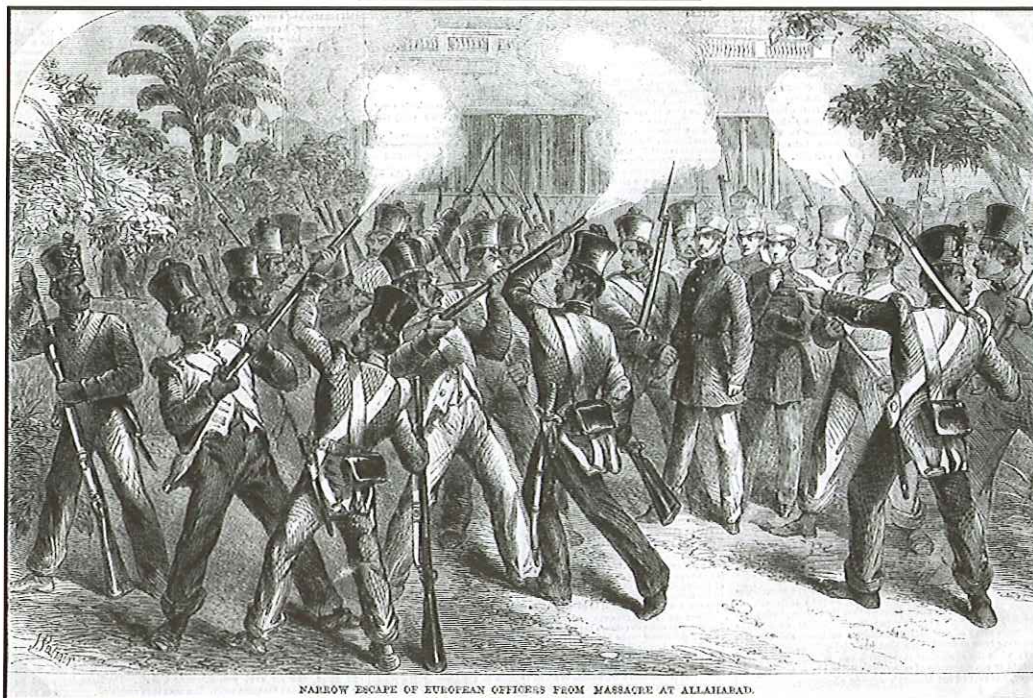
This outstanding postal history collection of the Campaign Mails includes hundreds of entires/covers, mostly with transcripts, details of origins and many with fascinating and detailed accounts of the individual campaigns, battles, skirmishes & ambushes, sometimes quite horrifying.

Included are sections entitled War with France (1751-61), Campaign Against the Dutch (1759), First Mahratta War (1775-82), Second Mysore War (1790-92), Third Mysore War (1799), First & Second Cutch Expedition (1814-15), Third Mahratta War (1817-19), Siege of Bhurtpore (1825-26), Conquest of Scinde (1843), Gwalior Campaign (1843), First & Second Sikh War (1845-49), Jowari Expedition, Noga, Mirandzai, Manipur, Chin-Lushai, Black Mountain Expeditions, various Blockades, Field Force cancels (Mahmoud, Waziristan, Tirah, Tochi etc.), The Indian Mutiny (1857-59) etc.

Many excellent adhesive frankings including earliest issues, many to Europe, Soldiers' rate covers, readdressed at destinations. Much collateral material including illustrations, engravings, drawings, maps, letters and documents to/from Generals and Commanders etc.

Invaluable as research material for military/postal history. A unique assembly with approximately 500 covers plus other material, weighing about 15kgs.

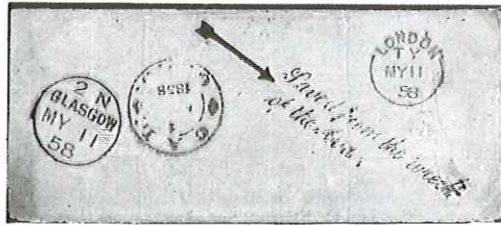


NARROW ESCAPE OF EUROPEAN OFFICERS FROM MASSACRE AT ALLAHABAD.

OFFICER'S ENTIRE LETTER WRITTEN BY BREVET-MAJOR J.M. BANNATINE HM 8th REGIMENT, FROM "CAMP NEAR FUTTEGHUR" TO SCOTLAND DATED 23rd JANUARY 1858.



MAJOR BANNATINE WAS BRIGADE MAJOR OF THE 3RD BRIGADE, ARMY OF OUDH COMMANDED BY BRIGADIER E.H. GREATHED. AFTER TAKING PART IN THE SECOND BATTLE OF CANNORE ON DECEMBER 6th 1857, THE WHOLE ARMY ADVANCED TOWARDS FUTTEGHUR. THE BRIDGE OVER THE KALI RIVER WAS FOUND DAMAGED AND DURING ITS REPAIR ON JANUARY 2nd THE TROOPS WERE ATTACKED. THE BRIGADE MOVED IN SUPPORT OF HMS 3rd REGIMENT THAT HAD BEEN FIRED UPON.

AFTER THE ACTION AND THE CAPTURE OF FUTTEGHUR THE FOLLOWING DAY, THE BRIGADE ENCAMPTED JUST OUTSIDE THE TOWN WHERE, AS REPORTED IN THIS LETTER, IT WAS BURNED UP.

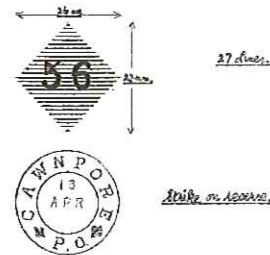
THIS LETTER WAS SENT BY BRIGADE BAG TO CALCUTTA BEARING POSTAGE. IT WAS CHARGED SIXPENCE ON ARRIVAL IN ENGLAND. THE FRONT SHOWS A 41x10 mm BOXED HANDSTAMP "INDIA UNPAID".

THE MAIL LEFT CALCUTTA ON FEBRUARY 10th ON BOARD THE SHIP "AVA" SAILING VIA CEYLON WHERE IT RAN AROUND ON FEBRUARY 10th. THE PASSENGERS WERE RESCUED AND THE MAIL RECOVERED. TO IDENTIFY THE CAUSE OF DELAY IN TRANSMISSION TIME NOTE THE CATCH "Saved from the wreck of the ship". THE LETTER REACHED ENGLAND ON MAY 11th 1858, NINETEEN DAYS AFTER LEAVING CALCUTTA.

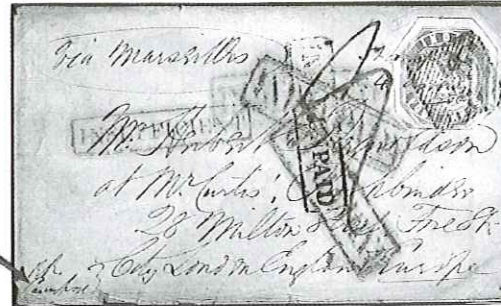

10058 (*) An apocryphal story concerning Sir Charles James Napier is

that when he crushed the Amirs of Scinde at Miani in India in 1843, he sent home a preliminary dispatch of a single word: "PECCAVI".*

Translated from Latin, that means "I have sinned". However, Napier was not blazoning his shortcomings, but rather punning the Latin word. He had conquered Scinde.

By 1852 Sir Henry Bartle Frere, appointed Commissioner of Scinde, had put the district on the road to prosperity. He reorganised the posts and issued postage stamps. They were not only the first stamps issued in the Indian subcontinent, but in the whole of Asia!

The stamp was issued in a rare EMBOSSED form on white paper, on blue paper and on a fascinating RED WAX. Inscribed "Scinde District Dawk", "Dawk" meaning "Post", it confirmed the postal use. In the centre is the logo of the East India Company, with the talismanic "4" above.

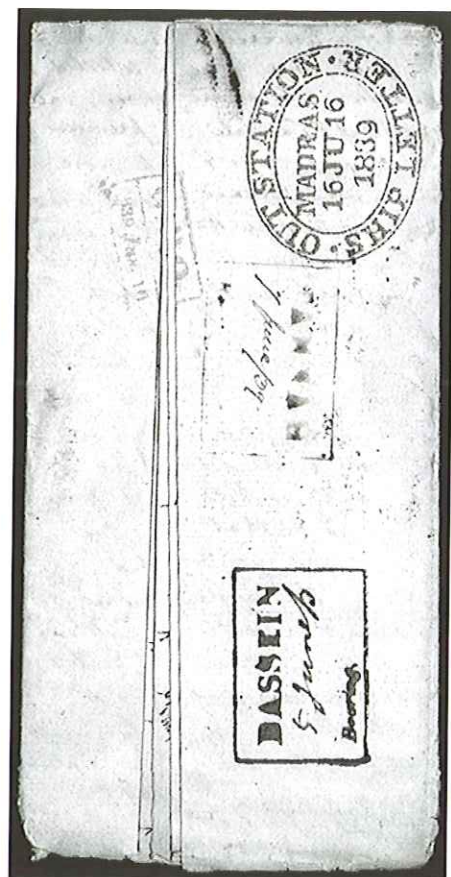
There is controversy about the original assignment of De La Rue of London as printers of the stamp, since the official records in India were destroyed and no authenticated contemporary record exists in London.

Because of its very delicate nature, the red wax stamp did not survive the decades well, and apart from being a very rare item, it is almost impossible to find an example in near to perfect condition.

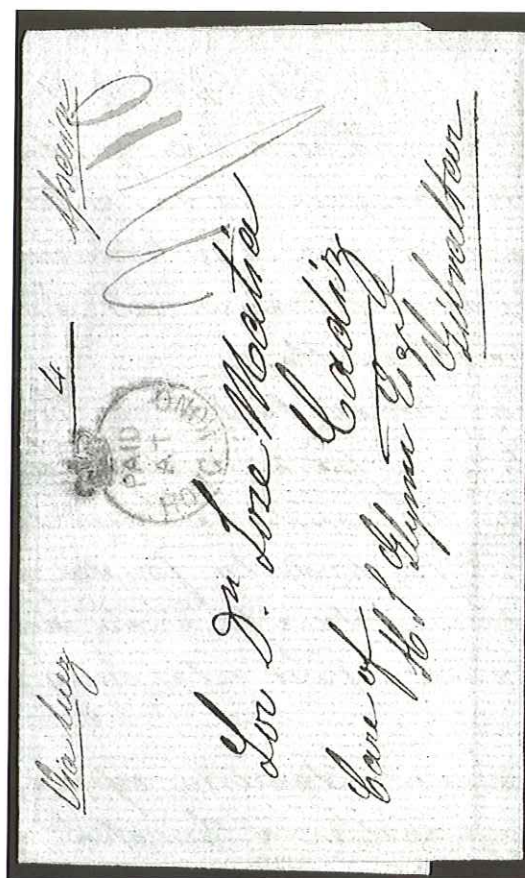
There was no sign or trace of an UNUSED example until this stamp surfaced when the great collection of Maurice Burrus was offered for sale in 1963 (lot 272, estimated £1500). It is of an unexpectedly fine quality, being almost perfect but for a small crack from near the centre to the 7 o'clock position. It passed through the ownership of an Indian Prince and has now come on the market once again, being offered at this Singapore '95 International Stamp Auction. Cert. RPS

It is the UNIQUE UNUSED example of ASIA'S FIRST STAMP.

The pair paid the new double internal letter rate introduced the same day.

The letter contains reference to the new adhesives & change of postal rates: "I have been waiting until the new postage came which is to-day. An overland letter which used to cost to Bombay before 15 annas comes to 1 anna, so you can fancy how very much they have reduced the postage."

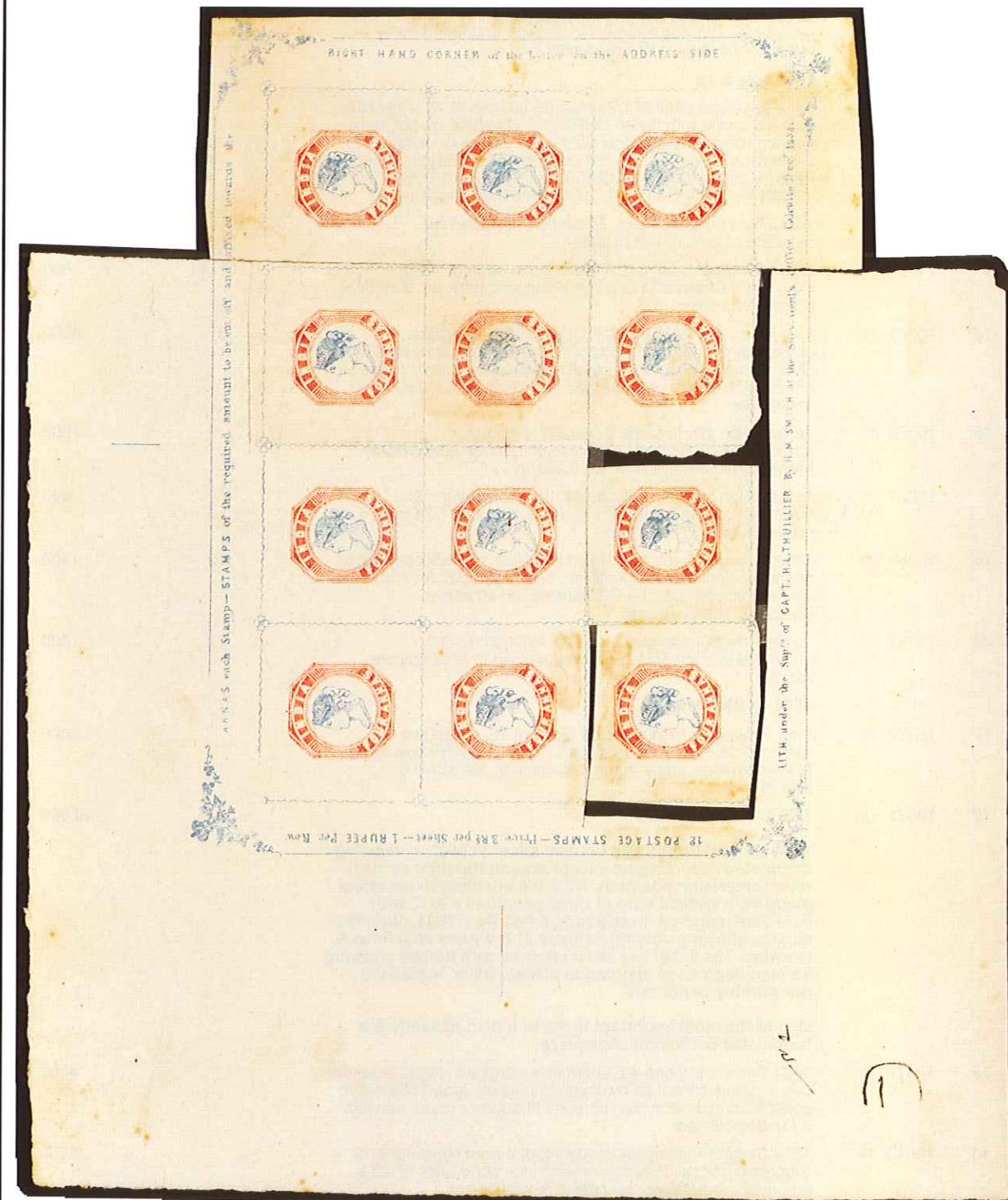

For over 20 years we have been offering properties of Thailand, but it was not until our auction of important Thailand collections in 1978 that native Thais personally participated. The formidable collections of C.M.Symes, Henry Madden, Walter Pears and Charles Stewart had now been dispersed and were being replaced by such names as Prakaipet Indusophon, Anatchai Rattakul, Yaovane Nirandara, Surajit Gongvatana and others.

Dr. Pichai Buranasombati turned his attention to Thai philately in the 1980's, though he has been an avid collector since he put together a fine "schoolboy" collection in 1955.

The classic period before and during the Rama V issues had always attracted the most attention amongst the traditional exhibitors. Pichai curiously concentrated on the issues of what is generally called the "Middle Period" - Rama VI, Rama VII and later.

This in fact proved to be a very fascinating area about which not so much was known and conversely to popular belief, the material was in very short supply and often much rarer than the classic issues. As "Westerners" had not collected so intensely, little correspondence was kept, and often only a handful of examples are known for many of the errors and scarce printings. Even moreso, the quality left much to be desired.

Dr. Pichai Buranasombati is Past-President of the Vocational Schools of Thailand, University lecturer in Business Management and Educational Administration and has recently been elected Director of the Philatelic Association of Thailand.

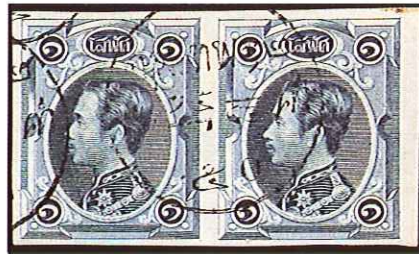

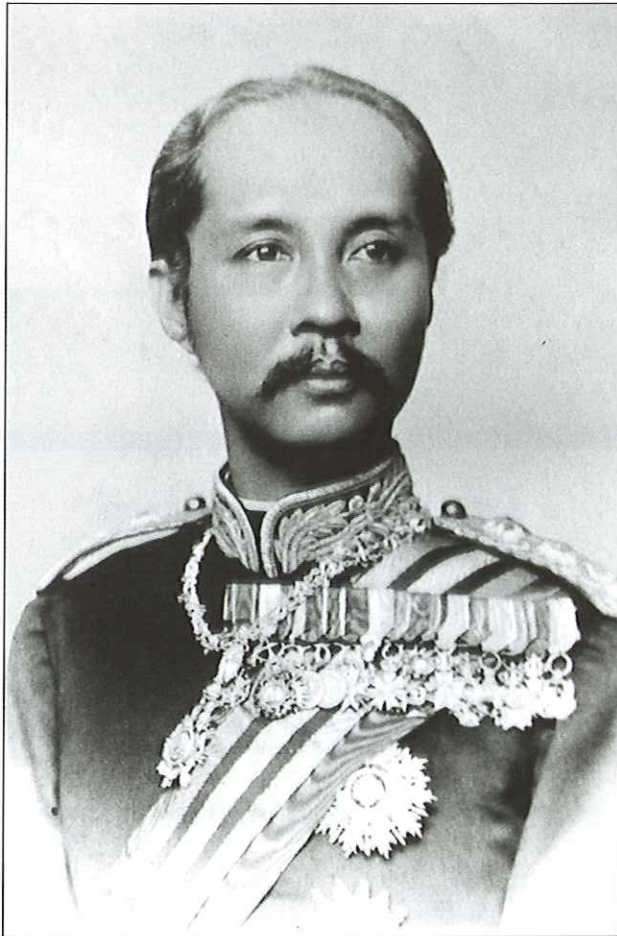

His Majesty King Chulalongkorn (Rama V : 1868-1910)



King Chulalongkorn succeeded to the throne of Siam in October, 1868 on the death of his father, H.M. King Mongkut (Rama IV). He was the first King of Siam to travel abroad and the first to send his sons to Europe to be educated. Among the advances in Siam during his reign of 42 years were the abolition of slavery; establishment of schools, hospitals; revising of the judicial system and tax laws; opening of the first tramway and the first railway in Siam; introduction of telephones, telegraph and the electric light. In 1883 the first postal service was begun in Bangkok and later expanded into the provinces. In 1885 Siam joined the Universal Postal Union, allowing the Kingdom to participate in international postal service.

His Majesty King Vajiravudh (Rama VI : 1910-1925)

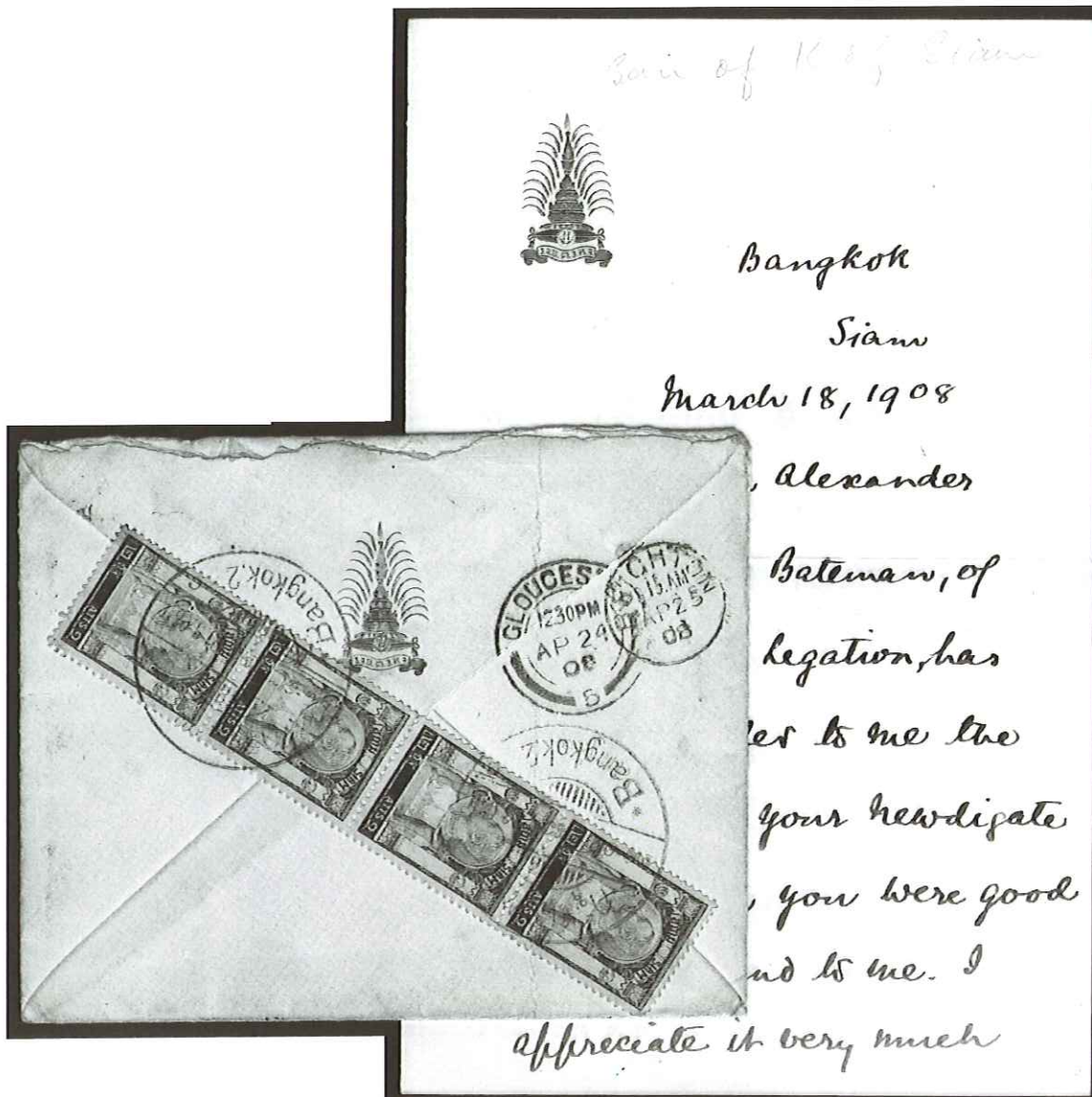


King Vajiravudh was the first King of Siam to be educated abroad. He was designated Crown Prince in 1895 following the death of the first Crown Prince, his elder half-brother. A prolific writer, his first book, written in English, was published while he was still a student in England. He wrote other books, plays, poetry and translated works of Shakespeare into Thai. During his reign compulsory education was begun; Boy Scouts were founded in Siam and the Elephant flag changed to the tri-colour still in use. An air force was established and an air mail service to remote areas of the Kingdom where there were no railways. For the first time in history Siamese were given surnames during the 6th reign. King Vajiravudh married late in life and left no heir to the throne.

His Majesty King Prahadhipok (Rama VII : 1925-1935)



King Prahadhipok was the youngest full brother of King Vajiravudh. He was educated in England, and being 4th in line of succession, never expected to become King. He planned a military career, but due to the premature death of his brothers, he succeeded to the throne on the death of King Rama VI. He became King at a difficult time, for the poor economy of western countries also affected that of Siam. His economic measures to save the Kingdom from bankruptcy made him unpopular among the military and the bureaucracy. In June 1932 a coup d'etat overthrew the absolute monarchy, and in December 1932 the first "permanent" constitution was promulgated. The King suffered poor health and in 1934 left for medical treatment in Europe. King Prahadhipok was the last absolute monarch of Siam; he abdicated the throne while in England, in March 1935. He never again returned to Siam and died in England in May 1941, leaving no heir.

His Majesty King Ananda Mahidol (Rama VIII : 1935-1946)



Prince Ananda, a grandson of H. M. King Chulalongkorn, was a student in Switzerland and not yet ten years old when he succeeded his uncle, King Prahadhipok, to the throne of Siam. Because he was not yet of age, a Council of Regency was appointed by the National Assembly. He returned to Siam for a visit in November 1938. H. M. King Ananda Mahidol returned to Switzerland again to continue his education and where the years of World War II were spent with his family. He returned to Siam after the war for another visit, late in 1945. He planned a return to Switzerland to continue his education in preparation for taking up his duties as King. This never came to pass, for tragically, the young King was found dead in the palace the day before he was to leave Siam. H. M. King Ananda Mahidol died before his coronation and he was unmarried.

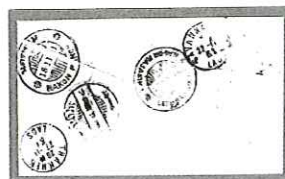

His Majesty King Bhumibol Adulyadej (Rama IX : 1946-to present)



H. M. King Bhumibol Adulyadej succeeded to the throne of Siam in June 1946 following the death of his older brother. His Majesty, 9th King of the Chakri Dynasty, is the longest reigning King of Thailand (formerly Siam). Thailand will celebrate the Golden Jubilee (50 years) of his reign in 1996, although celebrations will continue from January 1995 through the end of 1996. His Majesty was 18 years old when he became King, and also reigned under a Council of Regency. Following his return to Switzerland after the death of King Ananda, His Majesty changed his course of study from engineering to political science to better prepare for his life's work. On April 28 1950 he married Mom Rajawongse Sirikit Kittiyakara in Bangkok. On May 5th 1950 he was formally crowned His Majesty King Bhumibol Adulyadej in traditional Siamese Coronation ceremonies. The young King and Queen returned to Switzerland

where he continued his university studies. They returned home to stay in December, 1951. Their Majesties have four children; a son and three daughters. They have worked tirelessly throughout their reign to help the Thai people achieve a better life. His Majesty is a recognised authority on water resources and conservation. He is a talented painter, a photographer of professional ability, and a gifted composer and musician. He has travelled to the far corners of his country and visited every province in Thailand. He has established agricultural experiment stations in each of the major regions of Thailand, as well as one in the palace grounds of the Royal residence in Bangkok! He is deeply loved by his people. In 1988, by acclamation of the Thai people, "the Great" was added to his title making him H.M. King Bhumibol Adulyadej the Great - only the 3rd monarch of the Dynasty to be so honoured.

V - THE END OF THE WAR

MAIL FROM OAS SOLDIERS

At the end of the war in South East Asia allied POW's were liberated by the Allied Forces. Some of them remained in the camps as "on active soldiers" and performed different duties including the dispatch of the mails. Thailand at the time was considered enemy territory under occupation and, as such, had lost her postal privileges. To overcome this temporary difficulty, a team of Dutch ex-POW's under the command of Major Leemayer and Capt. Teelen, in collaboration and permission of the Armed Forces, the Thai Post Office and K.L.M. devised a new postal service, which consisted of external mails being carried by military aircraft directly to Batavia and hence by KLM regular service to Europe. This service started in January 1946. Due to the volume of correspondence handled it was required and supplied by the Thai Postal Authorities a special cds canceller which was in permanent use from 23-3-46 until closure of the office on 22-11-46.
