
Olympic Bell Model

The Berlin sculptor, Walter E. Lencke, has now completed his model from which the Olympic Bell will be cast. The body of the Bell stands approximately 7 feet 6 1/2 inches high, its crown 1 foot 1 inch, and the transverse beam from which it is suspended 3 feet 3 inches, while the clapper hangs out beyond for a foot 1 1/2 inches. Thus the total height is 14 feet. The diameter of the bell body at the lower edge is 9 feet, and the width of the beam just over 13 feet. Yet more impressive is the great weight of the bell, estimated at 10 tons, the clapper alone weighing 1 1/2 cwt. It took 4½ tons of clay to form the casting-model. The material from which it is to be cast is sand, and the work will last 4 to 5 months. The Bell will then be hung on the Leiter Tower, nearly 143 feet high, on the Assembly Ground of the Reich Sport Field in direct proximity to the Stadium. As is known, it will ring in the Olympic Games of 1936, wherefore it is inscribed: "I Call the Youth of the World".

Press Arrangements for the 1936 Games

If the Olympic Games are to achieve the success desired by their founders, that is, if they are to develop amongst the youth of the world a spirit of international friendship and idealism and to the same time through this ideal to awaken the feeling of solidarity, then the comprehensive cooperation of the world press is essential. The Organizing Committee for the Olympic Games at Berlin in 1936 has hitherto enjoyed this cooperation in full measure; it therefore regards it as its duty to do all in its power to lighten the task of the press. In the first place comes the allotment of places and facilities for work during the actual period of the games. There will be 500 seats for press representatives on the main stand in the Olympic Stadium, or 120 more than at Los Angeles; half will be reserved for the German press, and the other half for the foreign press. However, as the throng of press representatives might exceed the capacity of this accommodation, it is necessary that there should be a lifting of those to be admitted. The

These same conditions also apply to all transactions in auction lots taking place outside the realm of the auctions. Photographs count as part of the description with regard to the margins, perforation, centering, postmarks and all other visible attributes. The description of the lots mentions if the items are signed by recognised experts and/or accompanied by expert certificates.

1.2 As viewed in person: Before and during auction sales, all lots may be examined at our offices or at the auction location as scheduled in the auction catalogue and on the website. Persons or their agents attending a Live Room auction and/or who have viewed lots before any auction are understood to have examined all lots which they purchase and accept them as they are at the moment of the knocking-down and not necessarily as described.

2. AUCTION BIDS

Bids in between these steps will be adjusted according to the next highest bid step. The bidder is bound by his offer until a higher bid has been validly accepted.

2.2 The Huissier Judiciaire together with DAVID FELDMAN S.A. have full discretion to refuse any bidding, to divide any lot or lots, to combine any two or more lots and to withdraw any lot or lots from the sale without any cause giving any reason. DAVID FELDMAN S.A. may also bid on behalf of vendors in cases where reserve prices have been fixed. In these cases, the vendor is treated as a buyer and the auctioneer shall bid on his behalf upto reserve prices. Any reclamation regarding authenticity must come to the notice of DAVID FELDMAN S.A. on the delivery of the lots but at the latest within 30 days from that date. 




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
