





Introduction

The "Irina" Collection of Finland presents probably the finest array on the stamps and covers of the First Issue ever assembled in one collection. Formed over some fifty years the collection includes many of the great rarities which have not been available for a long time, including many items from the famous collection of Agathon Fabergé.

Foremost among these items is Finland's most famous and valuable philatelic item - the "Fabergé" cover with the four horizontal pairs of the 5 kopek stamp - illustrated on the front cover of our catalogue. This item purchased in the beginning for the collection was sold in 1979 for the record breaking price of CHF 550'000 to a European collector whose collection of rarities were auctioned a few years later. Sadly missing the item and wishing for its return, it was bought again for the "Irina" collection to the great joy of its owner. This kind of happening, strangely enough, has occurred several times in my experience in the philately business - passion plays tricks with us!

In this catalogue, the Fabergé cover is only one of a number of outstanding items notable for their rarity and quality. For example, we can mention the unused 5 kopek block of three, the two tête-bêche covers and the First Issue 5k+10k combination cover. For those who wish to form the most outstanding collection of Finland these items are a "must".

But there is much for all, and for collectors of more modest means. Our efforts to bring the auction "home" to Helsinki, Finland with the aid of our friend Kaj Hellman is with the interest to satisfy also the local specialised and general collector who would not normally travel to Geneva.

We hope the pieces finding new homes will bring as much pleasure and satisfaction to their new respective owners as they have over the years for the present one.

A word on expertise by Per Gummesson

The collection offered in this catalogue needs little introduction to the specialists. It has been well known for many years as one of the leading collections of classic Finland and certainly one of the most important offers of First Issue stamps and covers ever to come on the market.

When my long time friend David Feldman was preparing the catalogue, descriptions and lotting, he asked me to help with the expertise and certificates. I thought this was the opportune time to introduce another good friend, Cyril Schwenson, who is now becoming one of the leading official experts for classic Finland stamps and postal history.

Cyril was born in Helsinki and grew up in Tampere, Finland. Already as a child he started to seriously collect Finnish stamps aided by his mastering of both the Finnish and Swedish languages. In 1976 he moved to Germany and very

quickly became the leading specialist for Finnish philately in the Arge Nordische Staaten. In 1997 he was appointed the official BPP expert for Finland. He is also a member of HFF (Helsingfors Frimarkssamlare Forening) and I understand he is assisting in the completion of a reference manual on forgeries.

Over a period of more than 20 years he has developed a great knowledge and experience in the area by studying the issues in depth and following through the years all the material that

has come to the market. His very friendly character and great interest in researching especially postal history and prephilately brought him close contacts and discussions with many of the contemporary experts, specialists and collectors including myself.

I am personally very impressed by the seriousness and professionalism of Cyril Schwenson's work as an expert and strongly recommend his certificates as amongst the best in Finnish philately today.
