

The Illustrated Envelope

This extraordinary catalogue harkens back to an age when illustrated envelopes were fashionable, when personal creative expression found a new outlet in postal communication. Hassan Shaida's collection, presented here, spans the junction of the fine and the applied arts, from the last decades of the 19th century to the first decades of the 20th.

When the famous Mulready envelopes and letter sheets were roundly caricatured and decorated envelopes became a gentle pastime, the arts and techniques of printing had developed to the extent that illustration was everywhere – on packaging and posters, greetings cards and postcards. Graphic artists, specialising in works for the trade, were parallel to and more visible than the fine artists as far as the public was concerned.

No wonder, then, that anyone with a little of artistic talent (or at least inclination) seemed to want to make their mail special, by means of everything from calligraphic flourishes (*fig.1*), caricatures (*fig.2*), comic scenes or full-fledge paintings in miniature (*fig.3*), sometimes plagiarising the work of "real" artists or illustrators of the time (*fig.4*).


Many of the lots demonstrate this phenomenon, for example, the work of Hugh Rose, a "legitimate" artist whose envelope addressed to King Edward VII graces the cover of this catalogue. The cards drawn by Horace Pothecary (fig.5), sent to Edwardian stage star Ellen Terry's three nieces, employed self-portraits used in comic themes. A.J.G.Clayton (fig.6) used humour and talent to arrange his monthly meetings with his friend Albert Harris. Sir John Tenniel's illustrations to Lewis Carroll's "Alice" books (fig.7) were a fertile source of ideas (and plagiarism) for numerous cover artists.

Though many of the artists, professional and amateur, are now anonymous, the zeal of their work and the passion of their productions resound through the decades. Whether working in pencil, pen & ink, watercolour, gouache or even oil paints, the artists employed their tools in an attempt to demonstrate their regard for the addressee, to have something out of the ordinary drop through the mail slot, to make their mark in an increasingly uniform industrial world, to bring joy into everyday life in dreary England.

Most of these lots, preserved as keepsakes in family albums (and away from exposure to sunlight), have survived in fresh condition, fragile colours as vivid as when applied, and stand as a testimony to the indomitable human spirit, the need to be creative, to make a mark upon one's world. We sincerely hope you enjoy these many little masterpieces, and perhaps find one or more whose theme or other qualities entice you to treasure it for yourself.
