



How to bid live by Internet at the David Feldman auction

- CONNECT by logging on to our site at: www.davidfeldman.com
- 2. PRACTICE by trying out the simulator preparing you for the LIVE auction
- 3. REGISTER by choosing your own user name and password (you only need to register once - for all transactions)
- A. PRE BID by e-mailing your bids in advance in order to be sure not to miss lots. Pre bidding closes one day before the auction
- B. BID LIVE by simply following your lot on the screen and bid instantaneously with others worldwide
- SPECTATORS ONLY! Follow the auction, but without the possibility to bid







C. SPECTATOR



- Bidding normally starts in the auction room and the lot will be adjudicated ignoring the Internet unless an Internet bidder has been recognised before the last price is reached.
- Please click on the bid button as early as possible for your FIRST BID in the bidding as it may take a moment to connect via the server due to the differ ent Internet connection speeds around the world. Once your bid is relayed the auctioneer notes an Internet presence and will delay the bidding at the end giving you a chance to finalise your bid.
- When and only when there is an Internet bidder the display will show GOING GOING GONE! in sequence confirming the end of the bidding. You must get your final bid through at the moment of the display of the first GOING.
- Sometimes several Internet bids may be made at the same moment. The server accepts the first bid received and ignores the others at the same price. This explains why you may have bid but the next bid is NOT for you. Please bid again immediately.
- 5. Every Internet bidder is automatically awarded a credit limit of CHF 20'000 or equivalent in €. If more is required before the sale just send us an E-Mail at: "accounts@davidfeldman.com" mentioning the new desired credit limit. During the sale you can ask to increase your credit limit through the "Finance" page of the Live Auction Software. Please note that in this case a few minutes could be needed to receive the answer.
- 6. Because of persons who have missed lots because of auction speed, we strongly urge you to E-Mail us a listing of all lots or groups of lots on which you may bid (no obligation), so the auctioneer may be aware. We also suggest you to give us a phone number where we can reach you during the sale in case of any difficulties. THE "GUTE" COLLECTION OF THE POSTAL HISTORY OF THE SKILLING BANCO STAMPS

INTRODUCTION to the SKILLING BANCO period

(1.7.1855 until 30.6.1858)

In 1855 Sweden had 3.5 million inhabitants on an area of 449'000 sq. kms. Almost 55% of the surface was forested, thus forestry and farming by small landowners were the main occupations. The growing industrialization and trade were helped by the postal reforms with reduced rates and improved services, which can be followed up by the rapidly increased usage of stamps.

The aim of this collection was to make a survey of the usage of the 1855 Skilling Banco stamps, Sweden's first issue, consisting of five values. In 1856 these were completed with a single "black" stamp for the Stockholm local post. These six stamps showed various aspects of printings, deliveries and usages.

Printings and Deliveries had been assembled in their postal historical perspectives, which have been made possible due to records available in the postal archives, completed with special papers. The printer supplied a stamp depot, responsible for the deliveries, which were handled on a "first in and first out" basis. The delivery journal, called the "Controlbook" still exists, showing the exact numbers of each delivery to every Post Office.

Letter rates: with the introduction of stamps, Sweden also adopted uniform rates for the inland mail. For letters abroad, the old rates remained in effect, until new conventions necessitated changes. Franked covers are known to 19 different foreign countries, with eight of these known with one example only. Aside the Scandinavian countries, less then 200 foreign covers are recorded. Inland and foreign letters could also be sent without the usage of stamps.

Place handstamps: as the Swedish Postal Service was founded in 1636, in July 1855 there were 153 offices (Places) with 19 more added during the Skilling Banco period (which ended in connection with the currency change into "öre"values). The places are indexed (see pp. 18-19) according to their spelling at that time.

This collection has been accumulated over a period of more than 50 years, with my continuous respect of the cultural heritage absorbed in the philatelic material. Valuable information has been given to me by my fellow collectors and I wish to convey my sincere thanks to them, and to the staff at our Postal Museum in Stockholm, who willingly shared from their stored-up multitude of facts of Swedish postal history.


Gustaf Johansson was born on the small island of Gotland, Sweden. Gotland is situated in the Baltic Sea almost midway between Sweden and Russia. All the inhabitants are referred to by the mainland Swedes as "Gute," and this is the explanation as to why Gustaf Johansson uses the pseudonym "Gute" for his international philatelic exhibits.

Gustaf Johansson has been an entrepreneur all his life. However, he retired in the 70's and passed control of his business to other members of his family. His son Jöran Johansson is the managing director of the family business. Additionally, Jöran Johansson is also a keen philatelist who collects the 1869 issue of the United States. Gustaf's daughter, Ulla Olsson, also joins the team and is specialized in Iceland Postal Stationery, 19th century.

Apart from his Grand Prix winning Norwegian exhibit, Gustaf Johansson formed a collection of Swedish Postal History of the "Skilling Banco" stamps (the final portion of which is offered in this catalogue), which had been exhibited in the FIP Championship class and won four Gold medals and six Large Gold Medals. He was a member of the Royal Philatelic Society of London since 1990. Gustaf was appointed to sign the "Roll of Distinguished Philatelists" in 2003.

The "Gute" Collection has been distinguished with ten Gold or Large Gold medals in FIP international exhibitions between Filacept '88 and Belgica 2001.
