THE C.G.CONSTANTINIDES COLLECTION

It is with pleasure that we can offer in the following lots the complete collection of the Colonial Issues of Cyprus as formed by the late C.G.Constantinides.

Mr. Constantinides was throughout the earlier part of this century one of the foremost dealers and experts in Cyprus philately. Apart from the extensive stock of early issues he took great pride and interest in building up for himself an outstanding personal collection. It is this collection which is offered herewith.

It should be observed that the general quality of stamps mint and used, cancellations and postal history items are well above average. When a better item came into stock he would replace the less attractive stamp or cancel. Thus we have an excellent range of marginal/plate number pieces, often in complete sets. These are usually very scarce.

A last word must be given for his keen early interest in cancellations and postal history. Specialists & enthusiasts in the field should find many interesting items, & we advise careful inspection of the group lots and collections.
